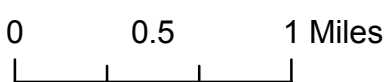


Highlands Preservation Buffer Legend

The buffer restrictions shown on the above map are outlined in the Stormwater Management Rule (N.J.A.C. 7:8), the Flood Hazard Area Control Act rule (N.J.A.C. 7:13), and the proposed amendments to the Surface Water Quality Standards rule (N.J.A.C. 7:9B),

As a result of the Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act, all water courses in the Highlands Preservation Area have 300 foot buffers.
